

4. God has a perfect plan and brings that plan to reality through His Holy Spirit:

- God's mind is incomprehensible. No one can actually understand His ways, or how He puts His design in place. God knew, God knows, nothing surprises him now (He never says oops) or ever will. Nothing comes into our lives that He does not already have a perfect plan for. Nothing comes into our life that isn't in the flow of His will and design for our good and His glory. His plan is always best for our lives- now and eternally (Jeremiah 29:11).
- Life often seems out of control and/or meaningless; but God has a plan to bring all these seemingly arbitrary and sometimes frustrating events to "good." This good is us being restored to the image that we were created to live in in the first place (Romans 8:28-29).
- God uses the person of His Holy Spirit to lead us down the path of bringing His perfect will to reality in our lives. The Holy Spirit shows us where we are off God's path (convicts of sin), and shows us where God desires us to be (righteousness/holiness). He leads us into all truth, and that truth is personally and eternally all encompassing (John 16:7-15).
- You are never beyond God's love, plan and control; no matter what might be happening in your life. God can take the worst of this world and make it eternally good for us. God can take the most disappointing dynamics in this world, and give us character and hope as a result of them.
- Actually believing this leads to rest, hope, peace and joy in the middle of whatever craziness this life may bring our way.
